SHELF LIFE & STORAGE OF RUBBER

Thank you for your enquiry regarding the shelf life of rubber.

It is impossible to give a totally accurate shelf life for material, as this obviously depends on the type of compound, storage/use conditions, temperature and regular inspections. If stored in ideal conditions as advised most material will be good for UP TO seven years. Ideally it should be checked after 5 years to ensure it is still within its spec and can then be kept for UP TO another 2 years. Obviously usage would have an effect and may shorten the life of the rubber.

BS3574 offers guidance on storage. Generally, the main criteria are fully wrapped away from ozone sources, electrical motors, magnetic forces, away from sunlight, water, oils and chemicals. Ideally it should be store in the dark and in temperatures between 15°C to 25°C.
